Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.42 dated 01.05.2015, under Sections 379, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Ramdas, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 06.08.2015:-

"The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case First Information Report No.42 dated 1.5.2015 registered under Sections 379, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Ramdas, Amrtisar Rural.

Notice of motion for 17.9.2015.

Meantime, the petitioners will join investigation. In case of their arrest, they shall be

enlarged on interim anticipatory bail by the Arresting Officer subject to the following conditions:-

1) that they shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

2) that they shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and ;

3) that they shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Sarwan Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation.

During the course of arguments, it has transpired that some other cases are also pending between the parties.

Keeping in view the above facts, it would be just and expedient to confirm the interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 06.08.2015.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 06.08.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
