This order will dispose of three petitions bearing Nos.

CRM -M 2609 of 2014, CRM -M 18990 of 2014 and CRM -M 26917 of 2014, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 71 dated 16.10.2009 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur (Annexure P1) along with consequential proceedings.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sangrur has been received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of Vijay Kumar, Chief Manager, Oriental Bank of Commerce, Feroz Gandhi Market, Ludhiana as well as statements of the accused. It is reported that the parties have voluntarily effected compromise and the same is without any pressure.

Perusal of the FIR shows that the allegations were of non-refunding of loan obtained from the bank. It is stated that now loan has been cleared. Basically, it was a monetary dispute between the bank and the accused. Now claim of the bank has been sastified.

Since the parties have effected compromise, FIR No. 71 dated 16.10.2009 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur (Annexure P1) alongwith the consequential proceedings stands quashed.

All the petitions are accordingly allowed.
