LISA GILL, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that order dated 04.08.2014 and 14.08.2014 stand complied with. A total sum of ₹ 1 lakh stands deposited in shape of three FDRs in the name of petitioner No. 1.

As per reply filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3, it is informed that representation dated 01.08.2014 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioners seeking protection of their life and liberty was inquired into. The petitioners were contacted at village Pie, where they are residing with family of petitioner No. 2 after marriage. The petitioners have submitted affidavits to the effect that they are living happily and peacefully. Parents of petitioner No. 2 are happy with the marriage. The petitioners stated that they did not require any protection at this stage.

Learned counsel for the petitioners on instructions submits that there is no immediate threat or danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, however, if any such threat is revived at the hands of respondents, he may be given liberty to approach respondent No. 2 for protection of life and liberty.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly. However, it is clarified that in case threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is revived on the basis of averments made in this petition, they may approach respondent No. 2, who shall look into the same and take necessary action as may be required.

Present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
