Petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in FIR No.178 dated 8.7.2015 registered under Sections 336, 506 and 34 IPC, under Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act and under Sections 3/4 of the SC/ST Act at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurminder Singh, Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.8.2015 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.
