SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.1 dated 03.01.2015, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar City.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 07.08.2015:-

"Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is a handicapped lady and was cheated by one Sunil Kumar, who sent to her appointment letter to join the office of Deputy Commissioner.

Notice of motion for 06.10.2015.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within a week. In the event of her arrest being required, she shall be released on interim bail till

the next date, subject to her furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, she shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which she shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to her.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Karam Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 07.08.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
