1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is third application filed by the petitioner for grant of interim bail, who is an accused in FIR No. 443, dated 31.12.2012, registered under Sections 304/34 IPC at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak, Haryana. The interim bail has been sought on the ground that the father of the petitioner is suffering from cancer and that the petitioner is to look after him.

The record placed on file shows that the father of the petitioner is suffering from cancer. However, the histopathology examination shows that it is moderately differentiated squamous cell

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carcinoma. One of the brother of the petitioner is already available in the house to look after his father. Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that he is 50% handicapped.

In this case, the murder of a neighbourer has taken place.

I am of the view that if the petitioner is granted interim bail, it is likely to create law and order problem in the locality and with the neighbour. No ground to grant interim bail is made out. The present petition is accordingly dismissed.
