The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.69 dated 09.06.2015 under Sections 306/149 of IPC registered at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala, Punjab.

Deceased Rajinder Kaur was married to Sandeep Singh, 17 years ago. They had three children and eldest one is 16 years old. The petitioner is the father-in-law who is stated to be 74 years old. Rajinder Kaur had consumed poison. The allegations were levelled that the in-laws family had started harassing the daughter-in-law after 1 ½ years of marriage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is suffering from several diseases and needs medical treatment and the trial would take long time. Counsel also urges that Naginder Kaur and Bhupinder Singh had been allowed anticipatory bail.

The petitioner was arrested on 20.06.2015. The petitioner is 74 years old. The deceased did not leave behind any dying declaration.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and the

fact that the trial will take long time, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
