The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.02, dated 1.4.2010, registered under Sections 323, 324, 307, 452, 450, 148, 149 of the IPC, at Police Station Airport, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that apart from the fact that in the inquiry the petitioner was found to be not present, even if the allegations are taken to be correct, the injury attributed to him is a simple injury.

Counsel for the complainant has argued that the inquiry was

completely vitiated because the petitioner himself is a police officer and the extent of his influence can be seen from the fact that not only he but four other persons who were attributed even grievous injury were kept in column No.2 by the prosecution and only now with the intervention of the Court that they have been summoned under Section 319 of the Cr.P.C.

In my considered opinion, this may not be the stage to evaluate all these assertions but considering the fact that the injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature, I do not deem it appropriate to deny him the concession of anticipatory bail. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
