Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.508 dated 15.06.2015, under Sections 498-A, 323, 506, 509, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 07.08.2015:-

“Learned senior counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioner no.1 is father-in-law and petitioner no.2 is mother-in-law of the complainant. Learned senior counsel further contends that there is no specific role attributed to the petitioners, however, only general allegations are levelled against them. This is a matrimonial dispute between the husband and complainant-wife. In fact,

there is ego clash on behalf of the complainant-wife as she is more educated than the son of the petitioners.

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Haryana, for 17.09.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall, however, join investigation as and when called for and they will also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Sub Inspector Rajesh has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 07.08.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
