Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.114 dated 10.03.2015 under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Central, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 07.08.2015 passed by this Court, he has brought an amount of Rs.1,20,000/- by way of bank draft in the name of the complainant Sh. Atul Mathur. The bank draft has been handed over to ASI Ramesh Chand, Police Station Central, Faridabad who has come to assist the learned counsel for the State in the present case, with a direction to him to hand over the same to the complainant, against proper receipt.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ramesh Chand, Police Station Central, Faridabad, submits that petitioner is no more required for the purpose of any further investigation in the present case.

In view of the above, instant petition for anticipatory bail is allowed and the interim order dated 07.08.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Sections 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
