This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to petitioners in a case registered against them vide FIR No.57 dated 26.05.2015 under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the outset, submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition in respect of petitioner No.1 with liberty to surrender before investigating agency/trial court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh submits that pursuant to order dated August 28, 2015, petitioner No.2 has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated August 28, 2015, is hereby made absolute, qua petitioner No.2 subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed in aforesaid terms.
