MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 407 of the Code of Criminal Procedure read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for transferring the criminal case arising out of FIR No.60 under Sections 498-A/406/323/34 IPC dated 12.08.2013 registered at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur on the ground that the petitioner is being pressurized to settle the matter.

On due consideration, I am of the view that the ground taken for the transfer of the case is unsustainable. If the petitioner's grievance is that she is under pressure to settle the matter from her relations then

a similar pressure would continue upon her regardless of the fact whether the proceedings are conducted at Sunam or Barnala. The petition is, therefore, held to be frivolous and is dismissed. In case, the petitioner has any grievance regarding any threat to her, she may approach the Court concerned who may take appropriate action to ensure that any person appearing before it is not influenced or threatened by anybody.
