Petitioners Prabhjot Kaur and Vicky Kumar have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their lives and liberty and to provide adequate security to protect them from respondent Nos.4 to 7, who are parents, uncle and other relative of petitioner No.1. The petitioners, who are present in Court today, further contend that they being major have solemnized marriage with their own consent in accordance with law. The private respondents are not accepting the marriage of the petitioners and are extending threats to them. The copy of educational certificate of petitioner No.1 (Annexures P-1), copy of driving license of petitioner No.2 (Annexure P-2), marriage certificate (Annexure P-3) and photographs (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners have been placed on record.

At this stage, respondent No.4 has put in appearance through Mr. H.R.Bhardwaj, Advocate. Respondent No.4 states that he and his family members are not giving any threat to the present petitioners.

Without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the petitioners to contact respondent Nos.2 and 3, who, after their satisfaction that the petitioners are actually facing threat, shall take necessary steps to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from private respondent Nos.4 to 7, as per law.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
