Notice issued to the respondent through his counsel Mr. Pradeep Bharti before the Id. trial court has been received back with the report that respondent is awaiting service and copy of notice has been affixed on the door of his house. He seems to have been duly served. Since, there is no representation on his behalf, he stands proceeded against ex parte.

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking issuance of direction to the Executing Court of Mr. Inderjit Singh, JMJC, Moga to decide the execution application No. RT-590-1/1/9/11 dated 19.01.2013 titled as “Jeewan Lata v. Rajinder Kumar”, under Section 125 Cr.P.C. as early as

possible and to get the amount of maintenance recovered from the respondent.

The execution application is pending since September 2011 and nothing could be recovered from the respondent.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the executing court to expedite the proceedings and to dispose of the execution application as early as possible, preferably within a period of 9 months.
