ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 382 dated 28.08.2014 registered at Police Station Sushant Lok, Gurgaon under Sections 394, 476, 379, 411, 201 IPC.

The allegations are that Shatru Rana was driving his Etios Taxi and had taken a passenger to Gurgaon. The complainant had parked his car to take rest at about 3.00 a.m. on 28.08.2014. Two young boys approached him to take them to the Domestic Airport, Delhi. They parked their motorcycle and boarded his car. Those persons asked the complainant to take the taxi towards the Power grid or the Metro Station as they wanted to withdraw some amount from the ATM. As the complainant reached near the Power grid, they asked him to stop the car and forced him to come out of the car and then started beating him. Injuries were inflicted with a broken beer bottle. The purse of the complainant was snatched. The complainant provided the registration number of the motorcycle which was later found to be stolen.

The police was able to trace the vehicle through GPS system that was installed in the taxi. The petitioner was arrested on the same day. The motorcycle was also found to be stolen from Vasant Vihar. Another FIR No. 922 dated 29.8.2014 had been registered against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody for almost a year and the trial is taking time and bail may be allowed.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail application and states that there are some more cases against the petitioner and the trial is proceeding and out of 11 witnesses 5 witnesses have already been examined.

This is not the only case against the petitioner. The allegations are serious. The petitioner is involved in highway robbery. There is one more FIR registered at Police Station Vasant Vihar, Delhi. The petitioner is not entitled to bail. The trial is also proceeding.

The petition is dismissed.
