Quashing of the FIR No.196 dated 17.08.2010 under Sections 324/323/452/506/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Line Batala, Police District Batala, Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) and its consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise, is being sought.

On account of a civil dispute between the family of the complainant and the petitioners on 14.08.2010, a scuffle took place when Renu Bedi raised a lalkara. The whole occurrence was witnessed by Suba Singh. The complainant and his maternal uncle Anup Singh was taken by Gurmeet Singh Malhi and Suba Singh to the civil hospital for treatment.

During the pendency of the trial, the matter has been compromised by the parties.

In compliance of the order dated 10.11.2014, status report

has been received from the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala (Duty) and the statements of parties have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter and the complainant has no objection if present FIR is quashed.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.196 dated 17.08.2010 under Sections 324/323/452/506/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Line Batala, Police District Batala, Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1), is quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of qua petitioners.
