Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct the fair investigation in FIR No.70 dated 6.5.2015 under Sections 454, 380, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga and for transferring the investigation to some other adjoining district.

In view of the judgment passed by the Apex Court in ***Sakiri Vasu Versus State of U.P. and others (2008) 2 SCC 409*** the petitioner has no right to seek investigation in the manner she likes, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of

with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police,
District Moga to look into the contents of representation dated 16.5.2015
(Annexure P-4) and to deal with the same in accordance with law.
