Petitioner Kulwant Singh seeks concession of regular bail in a case which was registered at the instance of Kulwant Singh alleging that non-applicant Harpreet Singh alongwith other members of unlawful assembly trespassed in the house of the complainant armed with weapons, fired shots on the family of the complainant killing Malkiat Singh. The

deceased was ex-MLA and he used to stop the accused persons from committing the illegal acts.

Earlier petition filed by the petitioner had been dismissed as withdrawn.

Since the material witnesses have been examined, the culpability of the petitioner cannot be determined without appreciation of evidence. It is felt that expression of opinion on merits at this stage might cause prejudice to the petitioner or the prosecution agency at the time of the trial.

Without expression of any opinion regarding the conspiracy, culpability and involvement of the petitioner, this petition is dismissed.
