Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 CrPC is for issuance of directions to respondents no.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.4 to 11.

A perusal of the paper book shows that all the private respondents reside in Rajasthan and even the petitioners belong to Rajasthan.

However, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at present the petitioners are residing at Village Jandwala, District Fatehabad, Haryana.

Having regard to the facts, as narrated in the case, this

Court finds that there is no material for the Court to take cognizance of the matter, as all the documents as being relied upon by the petitioners relates to Rajasthan.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he will be satisfied if a direction is issued to SSP, Fatehabad to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 5.8.2015 (Annexure P5).

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sulinder Kumar, AAG, Haryana accepts notice of this petition.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case including the validity of the marriage of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents no.2 – SSP, Fatehabad to look into the contents of the aforesaid representation dated 5.8.2015 (Annexure P5), stated to be submitted by the petitioners, in accordance with law.
