Prayer in this petition is for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.2 and 3.

In response to the notice issued by this Court, reply by way of affidavit of Balwinder Iqbal Singh Kahlon, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Model Town, Jalandhar on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 has been filed. Para No.4 of the preliminary submissions reads as under:-

“4. That the petitioner Parshotam has filed the present petition seeking protection to his life and liberty as well as of his brother Dharminder Gill. In this regard it is submitted that the present petition has been filed without any valid and reasonable cause. The said Dharminder Gill brother of the petitioner has been a habitual offender and as such, he has been booked various times by registering cases against him and ultimately he has been proceeded against 110 Cr.P.C. The allegations levelled in the petition by the petitioner are false and baseless. As such, the present petition deserves to be dismissed.”

Considering the aforesaid averments made in the written statement when the petitioner has no valid reasonable cause, the present petition is dismissed.
