JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail by the husband in case FIR No.6 dated 30.01.2015 under Section 306 of IPC registered with Police Station Old Shalley, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

The petitioner/accused-Hoshiar Singh and the deceased Amarjit Kaur were married since last 15 years and out of the wedlock, three children were born.

As per the allegations, the petitioner/accused (husband) demanded money from the parental house of the wife to go abroad for employment, resulting into the wife committed suicide in her matrimonial home by setting herself ablaze.

It is the conceded fact that the petitioner is stated to be in custody since 31.01.2015 and two of the prosecution witnesses stand examined and the case is at the stage of prosecution witnesses.

Without adverting upon the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that investigation is over, this Court finds that petitioner/accused-Hoshiar Singh deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Gurdaspur.
