ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.169 dated 12.09.2014, registered under Section 15/27-A of the NDPS Act, Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the co-accused Gurpreet Singh and Manjit Singh have been allowed bail and the recovery was two bags containing 27 kilograms of poppy husk and the trial would take time. Learned counsel states that petitioner was not the owner of the vehicle.

The petitioner is in custody since 14.09.2014. The co-accused are on bail. The trial will take long to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
