The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.170 dated 28.10.2014, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Bagha Purana, District Moga (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, the petitioner took a sum of Rs.1 Lac each from six different persons for getting their sons recruited in the Indian Army in the light of influence of the petitioner, who is stated to have retired as Captain from the Indian Army.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that a false case has been foisted upon the petitioner and the petitioner is in custody since 09.02.2015. He further submits that the case is triable by the Magistrate.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Chamkaur Singh, submits that out of 26 prosecution witnesses, 09 witnesses have since been

examined including 03 such persons, who are alleged to have made payments to the petitioner.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the facts of the case as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Moga.
