The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for the quashing of the FIR No.108, dated 11.08.2013, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kamboh, District Amritsar, along with all consequential proceedings on the basis of the compromise.

This Court vide order dated 20.05.2014 directed the parties to appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate to make their statements. Learned Illaqa Magistrate was also directed to send his/her report to this Court. Learned Illaqa Magistrate has recorded the statement of Amar Sharma, attorney of Col. Anil Kumar Sharma, complainant as well as the accused and has reported to this Court that parties have voluntarily entered into a compromise. Photocopy of the power of attorney of the complainant has been placed on file, showing that there was an authority to Amar Sharma, attorney of the complainant, to enter into a compromise.

A perusal of the FIR shows that basically it was a dispute regarding the execution of the sale deed. Since the matter has been amicably settled between the parties, therefore, the FIR in question along with all consequential proceedings stand quashed.

Petition is allowed accordingly.
