Petitioner was arrested in a case on 03.11.2014 in FIR No.594 of 2014 registered at Police Station Hodal and he has been acquitted in that case.

During interrogation in the said case, he had allegedly, on the basis of his confession in the present case was also arrested in this case. The FIR in the present case is dated 24.09.2014. Allegations against the petitioner is that he along with two others had robbed the truck of complainant Nathu Singh which was driven by Rakesh Kumar. The material witnesses have already been examined. As per the statement of the witnesses, the identity of the petitioner appears to be a debatable issue. The petitioner having been involved in the present case after his arrest in another case, also raises a debatable issue regarding his involvement in the present case.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
