LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner prays for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 145 dated 23.10.2014 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341/34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Dirba District Sangrur.

It is contended that co-accused Kala Singh has been granted interim relief by this Court on 20.01.2015 and the case is now pending for 16.03.2015. The petitioner claims parity with him.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties. It emerges that the injury attributed to the petitioner attracts rigors of Section 326 IPC. The petitioner has given gandas blow on the left arm of the complainant Satpal Singh. It is verified by learned counsel for the State that the said injury is a grievous injury there being a fracture of the arm.

In these circumstances, grant of interim relief to the co-accused Kala Singh is of no avail to the petitioner as Kala Singh has

been attributed a simple injury. He is not attributed any injury attracting Section 326 IPC.

Keeping in view the above, it is not considered just and expedient to extend the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
