RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J

Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR.53 dated 23.4.2015 under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC at Police Station C Division, Distt. Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender on 9.7.2015, he is ready to surrender before the learned trial court within a period of one week from today and the learned trial court may be directed to consider his bail application, keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, by passing an appropriate order, at an early date.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner at considerable length and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the learned trial court is

directed that if the petitioner surrenders before it within a period of one week from today, his bail application shall be considered, keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, while passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, at an early date.

With the above said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
