The instant petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No. 180, dated 10.10.2012, under Sections 420, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar, on the basis of a compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner having been confronted that the allegations against the petitioner/accused are with regard to having allegedly duped as many as 559 investors in the capacity of acting as a LIC agent and having collected premiums from the policy holders and having not deposited the same and the compromise having been entered into only in relation to one of such investors, he prays for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
