AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is an application for regular bail in case bearing FIR No.92 dated 13.04.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120 B, 279, 336 IPC at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula.

The allegation is that the petitioner was involved in smuggling liquor from Chandigarh to Punjab illegally. Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody since 20.04.2015 and the co-accused was granted bail by this Court on 22.6.2015.

Learned DAG on instructions from ASI Kashmir Singh, has accepted the fact that the owner and the Field Excise Officer have been released on bail.

In this view of the matter I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the present petitioner. Let him be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
