While the investigation is still in progress, the accused-petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C in FIR No. 118 dated 04.05.2014, under Sections 323, 324, 307, 380, 353, 186, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Kapurthala City, Kapurthala for quashing on the basis of compromise.

As per allegations of complainant-respondent No.2 Sarabjit Kaur, Staff Nurse in Government Hospital, Kapurthala, petitioners entered in the said hospital and injured Baljinder Sharma respondent No.3 a Security Guard.

Statements of Baljinder Sharma injured and complainant Sarabjit Kaur have been recorded before the Illaqa Magistrate regarding compromise. Report has been received from Chief Judicial Magistrate,

Kapurthala that the matter has been compromised voluntarily. Complainant and the injured have also furnished their affidavit in the Court today.

Taking into consideration the report of the trial Court, this Court is of the opinion that chances of conviction are remote in view of the affidavits furnished.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the condition that petitioners will deposit a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Sector 9, Chandigarh within a period of one month.
