This is a petition for quashing of FIR No.32 dated 12.03.2015 registered at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot at the instance of respondent No.2 alleging that the she was married to the petitioner but he had maltreated the complainant on account of demand of dowry articles.

Claiming that the matter has been compromised, the petitioner has filed this petition for quashing of FIR.

Challan has not been yet presented. The matrimonial matter having been resolved, it will be open to the investigating officer to record supplementary statement of the complainant and file cancellation report. It will be open to the complainant thereafter to

submit no objection to the cancellation report. In such eventuality, the Illaqa Magistrate shall accept the cancellation report.

The investigating officer is present in the Court. The complainant is directed to approach the investigating officer within a period of 15 days to get her supplementary statement recorded that the matter has been compromised. The same will not be ignored by the investigating officer as per Section 163(2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of with the abovesaid observations.
