JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking quashing of the order dated July 30, 2014 (Annexure P1) passed by Sub Divisional Magistrate, Rampura Phull, whereby respondent No.2 was allowed to visit abroad. Though, it appears from the contents of the petition as well as the orders passed by this Court earlier that previously respondent No.2 filed application for seeking permission to go abroad and after due consideration, it was declined. Surprisingly on dated July 30, 2014, a similar application was moved which was allowed.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that after passing of the order dated July 30, 2014, respondent No.2 has visited abroad and has returned. She is regularly appearing before the trial Court.

In view of the facts referred to above, instant petition has rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such. However, trial Court is directed that in case any such application is moved by respondent No.2 in future, the same be decided after giving notice to the petitioner.
