The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.344 dated 25.08.2014, registered under Sections 366, 376(2)(d), 506, 344, 120-B IPC, Police Station Sadar Sonapat, District Sonapat.

Heard.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that the prosecutrix was married to the petitioner and it was a run away marriage and they stayed together for one and a half year and a child was born and thereafter, things did not work well and the parties separated and affidavits were sworn in on 14.07.2014 and later the FIR has been got registered. He states that the prosecutrix has made her statement in the Court and the co-

accused has been allowed bail.

The facts are disputed. The trial would take time. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
