Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Mukesh, brother of the deceased.

Story of the prosecution is that Balbir Singh had been killed by Nasib with whom Anita wife of Balbir Singh had allegedly illicit relations. So far as the petitioner is concerned, he has been involved in the case on the basis of a disclosure statement made by the main accused, Nasib.

It is not out of place to observe here that Nasib had made a disclosure statement in custody on 14.09.2013 wherein he had named Joginder to be his accomplice. On 16.09.2013, he allegedly made second disclosure statement involving the petitioner also. Disclosure statement of Anita was also allegedly recorded wherein she has not named the petitioner to have accompanied with the main accused, Nasib. The petitioner was arrested on 20.09.2014 and has allegedly made a disclosure in

police custody.

I have gone through the disclosure statements wherein participation of Nasib and Joginder is reflected. The evidentiary value of the aforesaid disclosure statements will be adjudicated upon during trial.

In view of the above circumstances, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
