The petitioner was summoned in a complaint case registered under Negotiable Instruments Act. He had been released on bail. The petitioner failed to appear before the trial Court on 15.05.2015. The reason given by him is that his son was suffering from Epilepsy and he had been taken to the hospital and treatment was to be given. The petitioner approached the Sessions Court and anticipatory bail application had been rejected.

Heard.

Perusal of Annexure P-3 shows that the Additional Sessions Judge had granted bail to the petitioner on 20.03.2015. The accused failed to appear before the Court and approached the Additional Sessions Judge again with a second application which has been rejected.

In the light of this background, the petitioner is not entitled to any protection. The petitioner would surrender before the trial Court on 20.08.2015 and the trial Court would consider the application as per law.
