AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents No.2 to 4 to register an FIR on complaint dated 09.07.2015 moved by her regarding the death of her brother.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 22.07.2015 (Annexure P-3) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide the representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-DGP,

Haryana is directed to look into the matter/representation (Annexure P-3)

and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
