Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 18.11.2014 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has been released on interim bail.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the factum of joining the investigation and recovery of weapon but opposes anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Rajinder Singh has also been released on interim bail and the same has been made absolute on 18.11.2014 in CRM-M-17605 of 2014.

In view of the submissions made above and taking into consideration the parity with co-accused, namely, Rajinder Singh, interim order dated 18.11.2014 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
