The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the Appellate Court to decide the appeal bearing No.G4/35303 dated 20.12.2013 titled “Dr. Manjit Singh Gill Vs. Dilbagh Singh”, pending in the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar arising out of Complaint No.1439 dated 10.1.2009 decided vide order dated 25.11.2013 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the appeal in this case is pending since 2012 and it has not been decided by the Appellate Court/Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar.
