The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 91, dated 16.6.2015, registered under Section 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Surinderpal Khanna, Superintendent Central Jail, Ludhiana has been filed.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that 30 kgs of poppy husk was allegedly recovered from the petitioner which is a non-commercial quantity and that the petitioner has been in custody for two months and no other case is pending against him.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep

Rai, has accepted the factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner as well as the fact that the contraband recovered is a non-commercial quantity, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the Ilaqa/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
