Petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.158 dated 26.05.2015 under Sections 379/382/323/506/431/326/447/148/149 IPC and 25/27 Arms Act 1959 registered at Police Station Patti, District Taran Tarn at the instance of respondent No.3 alleging that the petitioners had broken the pipes for drainage with sluggers after root capping them and committed theft by carrying these pipes in trolley.

Counsel for the complainant has put in appearance to state that the matter has been compromised. On asking of the Court, State counsel informs that the challan has not yet been presented.

In view of the said circumstances, this petition is disposed of, at this stage, with liberty to the complainant and other affected parties to appear before the investigating officer and get recorded their supplementary statements. If, on the basis of supplementary statements, the prosecution agency is of the opinion that the cancellation report/untraced report is to be submitted, it will be open to the investigating agency to present the concerned report.

Complainant can make a statement regarding their no objection to the acceptance of the cancellation report in the said eventuality within a period of one month.
