Petitioner and respondent no.4 are stated to be Directors of a private limited company-M/s Sarvpriya Tubes Pvt.Ltd.

It is submitted that respondent no.4 has committed certain acts of omission and commission to the prejudice of the said company which amounts to fraud and embezzlement. A complaint is stated to have been filed and inquired into by SSP Fatehgarh Sahib. By referring to a Memo dated 6.5.2015(P-4) it is suggested that prima facie allegations were found to be correct, however, it was noticed that jurisdiction to complete the investigations was with SSP Patiala.

Grievance of the petitioner is that inspite of reference made in P-4, no action is being taken by the police authorities at Patiala.

After hearing counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not deem it appropriate to interfere at this stage since there is no reason to

believe that the office of SSP Patiala or SHO concerned would not complete the investigations within a reasonable time.

Dismissed as premature.
