Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.80 dated 24.5.2015 under Sections 363 and 366-A read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

This Court vide order dated 12.8.2015 granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to his joining investigation and complying the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 12.8.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his

custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the instant petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 12.8.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
