Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Surjit Kaur in case FIR No.89 dated 28.07.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 419, 410, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 205 & 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Lahori Gate, Patiala.

The petitioner is a *Lambardar* and as per the allegations she identified two impersonators as one Rinku and Vikas residents of Patiala on the basis of alleged forged documents, as told by co-accused in order to facilitate the impersonators to stand surety for accused, who were residents of UP and facing trial *inter alia* for dacoity.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner
prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
