Petitioner is wife of Raj Kumar, who is an accused in a case registered at the instance of Sunil Kumar alleging that on 25.02.2015 when he along with his brother Kapil, Rajesh and others was present on Rajgarh Road, Bhiwani, Raj Kumar, Sunil, Anil, Rinku, Pradeep, Sandeep, Sanjay and Sonu alongwith 4-5 other persons came in two vehicles armed with revolvers and rifles. Raj Kumar, husband of the petitioner demanded Rs. 10 lacs as ransom from Kapil. On refusal of Kapil to pay the money, he was fired at, resulting in 18 bullet injuries whereas Rajesh suffered 5-6 bullet injuries while intervening. Both, Kapil and Rajesh died on the spot.

So far as petitioner is concerned, she has been involved in the case on the allegations that she conspired with her husband Raj Kumar to kill Kapil and Rajesh, on the basis of disclosure statement made by co-accused of the petitioner namely Sunil Kumar. Besides this, there does not appear to be any material to establish the conspiracy.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case at this stage, taking into consideration the nature of material gathered against the petitioner, she can be granted the concession of bail.

In view of above said circumstances, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
