The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.15 dated 23.02.2014, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 427, 506, 382, 148, 149 of IPC and under Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner/accused-Jaspal Singh @ Pala was armed with a Datar and caused damage to the vehicle of the complainant, while two other co-accused fired shots causing gun shot injuries to the complainant-Dan Singh and another person.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner states that the investigations are over and the petitioner is in custody since 01.05.2015.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from, ASI Sanjivan Singh, submits that the challan has been presented on 28.07.2015.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the fact that the investigation is over and the trial would take considerable period of time, no purpose would be served to keep the petitioner/accused-Jaspal Singh @ Pala in custody any longer, the prayer of Jaspal Singh @ Pala for regular bail is allowed and accordingly, he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Tarn Taran.
