Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.16 dated 09.01.2015, registered at Police Station Model Town, Rewari, District Rewari, under Section(s) 3/7/10 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 and Sections 420 and 120-B IPC (Sections 420 and 120-B IPC added lateron).
