Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Manpreet Singh states that petitioner Baljit Singh has also joined the investigation. A perusal of police file shows that injuries alleged to have been given with *datar* on the little finger of the right hand of the complainant is found to be lacerated wound. It will be debatable point whether with *datar* lacerated wound could be caused on the little finger. Perusal of the police file also shows that during interrogation, the petitioner has disclosed that he has thrown the *datar* at an unknown place.

Therefore, further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not necessary, as such interim bail granted to the petitioner on 29.1.2015 is made absolute.

The petition is accordingly allowed
