This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.671 dated 29.09.2014 registered under Sections 148, 149, 307 & 450 IPC at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner No.1 is behind the bars since 09.10.2014 and petitioner No.2 is behind bars since 29.09.2014 and the complainant has turned hostile and other witnesses have yet to be examined.

Be that as it may, petitioner No.1 is behind the bars since 09.10.2014 and petitioner No.2 is behind the bars since 29.09.2014, taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, petitioners can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial court/Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar.
