Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.68 dated 25.08.2013, under Sections 307, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Mullepur.

While issuing, notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 12.08.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been summoned to face the trial on an application moved by the prosecution under Section 319 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
