Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0165 dated 20.07.2015, under Sections 15(2), 15(3) of the Indian Medical Council Act and Sections 420, 417 and 336 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Kunjpura, Karnal.

It is contended that a false case has been foisted upon the petitioner on the original complaint of one Des Raj son of Roshan Lal with whom there is history of previous criminal litigation as per judgments (**Annexures P-1 to P-3**) and, therefore, enmity. It is further contended that except alleged offence under Section 420 IPC, rest of the offences are bailable and no offence is made out since there is no allegation regarding practice, prescription or administering/dispensing any allopathic medicine to any villager by the petitioner. It is submitted that the allegations are vague just to harass the petitioner.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from A.S.I. Abhey Ram, submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 12.08.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 12.08.2015 is made absolute.
